The Peggy Browning Award is presented annually to social justice champions who have distinguished themselves with passion and dedication to the rights and needs of workers and their families.



The Peggy Browning Fund is a 501(c)3 organization that educates and inspires the next generation of advocates for workplace justice through fellowships, workers' rights conferences, regional workshops, networking and other programs.

PBF was established in 1997 in memory of Margaret A. Browning, a prominent labor attorney and the first union lawyer appointed a Member of the National Labor Relations Board.

In 2018 PBF awarded 81 law students with 10-week Summer Fellowships working for unions, worker centers, non-profit organizations and union-side law firms advocating for the rights of workers and their families.

Of our graduated alumni, 68% are working in Workers' Rights Labor Law or Public Interest Law.
